The main aim of cultural association is to provide an opportunity to the students to express their hidden talents and to promote cultural interest among the student community. Cultural association has conducted 24 competitions during this academic year in connection with the college day and other related events. The association supervises certificate courses like yoga, beautician, journalism, music, dance, drama, short film etc.

### **College Library:**

Mr. Micheal Pinto is the librarian assisted by Mr. Denis DMello and Mr. Ronal Carlo.

*Our Library is a veritable store house of knowledge, equipped not only with printed books but also with internet and online database for e-books and e- journals. The stock of the books in the library has been considerably increased to cater to intellectual needs of the faculty and the students. At present we have 24,658 books costing Rs.26,30,388.. During 2018-19 we have already added 239 books worth of Rs. 38,861.00. 8 daily newspapers and 62 periodicals on different subjects are being subscribed spending more than Rs.54,000.00. Apart from overnight and weekly issues, 1181 books have been issued to 264 students under Book Bank Scheme this year. Our Alumni members and even outsiders also make use of our Library. We have 9 computers in the library with broad band internet facility, 7 computers exclusively for the staff and students, To make the library facility more user friendly to the members and to have the information of their choice, we have installed a Standard Digital\Library Software “Easylib” and computerized the library*

*resources. In order to enrich the resources of the library we have registered our college with INFLIBNET for Online full text access to e-journals and e-books under N-LIST programme. For the benefit of the readers we have computerized printed catalogues of books apart from “OPAC” (Online Public Access Catalogues). We have separate library for the P.G. students which holds 790 books worth of Rs. 2,98,874. During 2018-19 we have added 52 books costing Rs. 25,690. 6 news papers and 1 periodicals are being subscribed for the P.G. Library spending more than Rs.25000*

### **Student Support:**

Scholarships: Rs. 2,45,520 has been disbursed to 82 students in the form of different scholarships and Rs. 3,67,170 is distributed to M.Com students as fee concession and other scholarships. .

**Mid-day Meal Scheme** is yet another student support programme. This scheme is well managed by Mr. Richard R Sequeira. The scheme runs out of midday meal fund and the contribution by staff members, Alumni, Parents and many well wishers. 100 Students benefit from the scheme. We are grateful to all the generous contributors.

### **Associations/Cells**

Associations and cells function to promote the co-curricular interest of the students.
