


10. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




11. How well did the teachers prepare for all the classes?




12. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




13. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




14. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




15. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?








17. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.










21. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.










24. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.










