Report of the NSS and YRC activities conducted during 2017-18

Following is the concise report of the National Service Scheme Unit of Pompei College during the academic year 2017-18.

1. **21.06.2017 - International Yoga Day:** Along with the NCC Naval unit of the college the International Yoga day was celebrated. Bhavyashree, II BA Student, a practitioner of yoga trained the volunteers for nearly two hours in which all volunteers cheerfully participated. A formal programme marking the day was conducted which was presided over by our Principal, Dr John C Miranda.





2. **15.07.2017 - Inauguration of the annual activities:** A formal inauguration programme was arranged to mark the inauguration of the NSS activities for the year 2017-18. Mr Divakar Chowta, President, Aikala Gram Panchayath was the chief guest. Formal programme was followed by cultural performance by the NSS volunteers.







3. **22.07.2017 - Shramadhana at Aikala village:** volunteers cleaned Moorukaveri and both sides of the main road and drainage from Moorukaveri to Aikala Gram Panchayath. Picking plastics from the drainage was mainly focused.





4. **29.07.2017 - Shramadhana for Vanamahotsava at college campus:** As part of Vanamahotsava programme, the place was cleared and markings were made to dig pits to plant the plants









5. **03.08.2017 – Vanamahotsava:** A programme was arranged to mark the planting of thousand plants in association with the Forest Department and Eva Green, an NGO who provided us plants. On this occasion some plants were also planted.







6. **05.08.2017 - Water conservation Programme:** In association with different voluntary organisations, NSS unit organized a mega water conservation awareness programme which involved two kilometer procession from the campus of Pompei College to Kinnigoli bus stand; an oath administering to preserve the water and the enactment of the street play. Rev Fr Vincent Monteiro, Chief priest of Our Lady of Immaculate Conception Church, Kinnigoli enlightened the volunteers about the importance of preserving water.

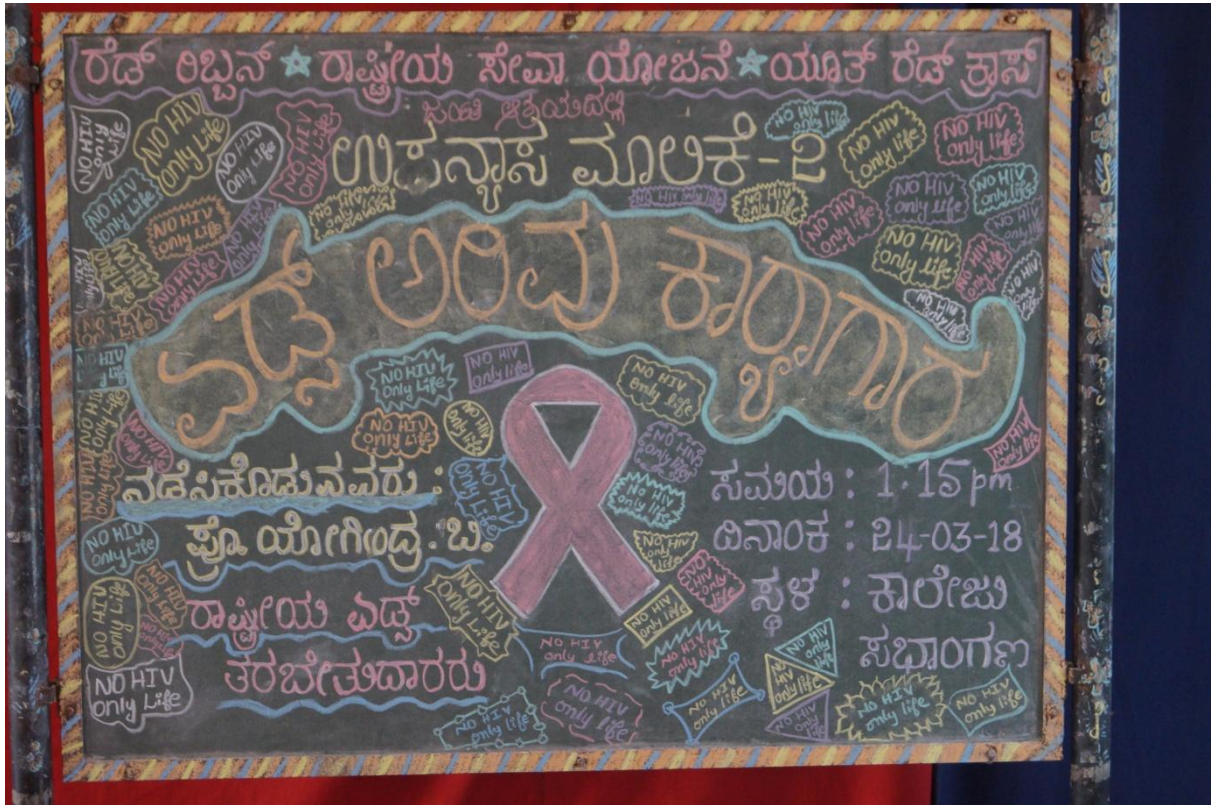


27. **21.03.2018 - Awareness programme – SVEEP- Importance of voting in Democracy:**
