PARTICIPATION IN CAMPS

- ❖ Leading Cadet Sulaiman Ziad II B.Com B participated in State Level Nau Sainik Camps Phase I, II and III held at Udipi in September and October 2016. He has completed **All India Nau Sainik Camp held at INS Kadamba, Karwar from 06 October to 17 October 2016.**
- ❖ International Yoga Day was celebrated in Association with 5 Karnataka Naval Unit Mangalore on 21st June 2016 in the college auditorium. Principal Dr. J C Miranda was presided over the function.
