I. INTRODUCTION

The Students' Welfare Council is constituted with two elected representatives from each class. The Council is guided by a teacher, who is designated as "Students' Welfare Officer". The meetings of the Council are being held regularly. The principal of the college presides over the meetings. The various student centered matters are discussed in the meeting. The council also takes the decisions with regard to organizing various activities in the college.

II. OBJECTIVES

1. To inculcate democratic spirit among the youth.
2. To develop leadership qualities.
3. To encourage students' participation in various college activities.
4. To improve Staff – Student relationship in the college.
5. To provide leadership for youth movements.
6. All round development of students' community.

III. FUNDING

There is no separate fund for the council. However, any financial need of the Council is met from the college account.

IV. FORMATION OF THE COUNCIL

The Council will be formed within a week of the beginning of the academic year. Class teachers of each class take the initiatives to elect two representatives, one male and one female from each class.

V. CONSTITUTION

1. The Council is not affiliated to any political party.
2. Any strike/ protest given by any political party are not entertained.

3. Any strike or protest call to be given by the Council, must be given in the form of a notice to the Principal through the Students' Welfare Officer, 24 hours in advance.
4. Students' Welfare Officer takes decisions in consultation with the consent of the Principal.
5. The office bearers to the Students' Welfare Council are selected in the beginning of the academic year and their term ends at the end of the academic year.
